DOC2AMU Doctoral Programme

DOC2AMU is an innovative COFUND doctoral programme built on principles of **interdisciplinarity, intersectorality and international perspective (3I)**. It is coordinated by Aix-Marseille Université's Doctoral College and is co-financed by the Provence-Alpes-Côte d'Azur Regional Council and the European Union's Horizon 2020 research and innovation programme under the Marie Skłodowska-Curie grant agreement No 713750, with a financial support from the A*MIDEX Foundation.

A programme anchored in the "3I" principles:

- **Interdisciplinarity** : collaborative thesis projects between two research units tied to two distinct doctoral schools, and set in one of six interdisciplinary research topics: globalization, big data, networks, Nano-health, climate change and imaging.
- **Intersectorality** : partnerships with non-academic actors during the thesis (through secondment or mentoring).
- **International perspective** : the programme is directed at early-stage researchers who fit the Marie-Sklodowska-Curie Actions mobility rule, and offers short international research stays during the thesis.

A word from the Director of the Doctoral College

DOC2AMU is a pilot programme that will structure AMU's doctoral training, with the final goal of generalizing the **Innovative Doctoral Principles** recommended by the European Commission.

Features

The programme also includes an innovative and extensive training offer with **50 hours of mandatory transferable skills training**, including for example a **business creation course** and a **course on European project engineering**.

Several communication and dissemination activities will allow DOC2AMU early-stage researchers to share the results of their research activity, including the **Doctoral Days**, where their work is evaluated by a scientific committee and presented to the public.
